Re: Notification Letter for CLI-CR-19-3.34 (PID 119809) Second Creek Road Reconstruction Project

To Whom it May Concern:

The Clinton County Engineer's Office, in partnership with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), is proposing to reconstruct approximately 1.5 miles of Second Creek Road (County Road 19) from Tar Pike to Shull Road in Marion Township, Clinton County, Ohio. The improvements also include widening the roadway shoulders, modifying ditch slopes, removing fixed objects to increase visibility along the roadway, and adding wider edge line striping and rumble strips. This project will require permanent and temporary right-of-way acquisition. Construction is currently scheduled to begin in August 2026 and be completed in September 2027.

The proposed work will require closure of Second Creek Road for approximately 150 days. Traffic will be detoured using Tar Pike to State Route 28 to U.S. Route 68. See included Detour Map for reference. Detour information will be posted in advance of the roadway closure. Access shall be maintained to all adjacent properties for the duration of the project.

As a service provider, we wish to inform you about this project. The Clinton County Engineer's Office is seeking comments from the public about the social, environmental, and economic impacts of this proposed project. Environmental impacts include those involving archaeological, architectural, maintenance of traffic/access to properties, ecological resources, hazardous materials, and the general location of the project.
